Drowning Prevention Week – July 15-21

Notice of Application of Larvicide for Mosquito Control in BWG

From July 16, 2018 to August 24, 2018, the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, under the authority of the Simcoe Muskoka Medical Officer of Health will conduct a program to control mosquito larvae (immature mosquitoes) in standing water in order to prevent their development into potential carriers of West Nile Virus. The program will be carried out in Bradford West Gwillimbury including subdivisions of Golfview, Kilkenny Trail, Foster's Forest and Emery Estates Subdivision.

The larvicide (Altosid Pellets PCP#21809, pellet formulation) and (Mosquiron 0.12CRD PCP#31079,) will be applied by direct hand application to catch basins of storm drains in the following area: 8th Line to 6th Line and Holland River to Sideroad 10 and subdivisions noted above.

The larvicide (Altosid Methoprene PCP#21809,) is a registered larvicide approved for use by the federal government. This application will be carried out by Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change licensed applicators or trained technicians. For details on locations and dates of treatment call 905-775-369.

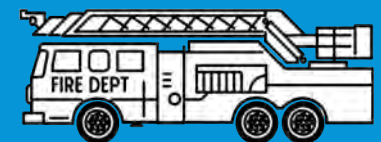

Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (s.32)

NOTICE is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury that Nomination Papers for those persons who propose to be a candidate in the 2018 Municipal Election are available at the Administrative Centre, 100 Dissette Street, Units 7 & 8, Bradford or on the Town's website at www.townofbwg.com/election

Nomination Forms for the following offices may be filed in person or through an agent with the Clerk (or designate) of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury during the regular business hours of 8:30 a.m and 4:30 p.m. between May 1, 2018, and July 26, 2018; and between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m., on July 27, 2018, Nomination Day.

- **1 MAYOR** (Elected at Large)
- **1 DEPUTY MAYOR** (Elected at Large)
- **7 COUNCILLORS** (1 Elected from each Ward)
- **1 TRUSTEE**, Simcoe County District School Board, English Public (Elected at Large); Geographic Area: Bradford West Gwillimbury
- **1 TRUSTEE**, Simcoe Muskoka Catholic District School Board, English Separate (Elected at Large); Geographic Area: Bradford West Gwillimbury and Innisfil

Nomination Forms for the following French Language School Board Trustee positions must be filed at the City of Barrie, 70 Collier St, Barrie.

- **1 TRUSTEE**, Conseil Scolaire Viamonde, French Public (Elected at Large); Geographic Area: Counties of Simcoe, Bruce, Dufferin and Grey
- **1 TRUSTEE**, Conseil Scolaire Catholique MonAvenir, French Separate (Elected at Large); Geographic Area: Simcoe-Muskoka

Nomination Procedure:

A person may be nominated for an office by filing Nomination Papers with the Clerk or designate. The nomination shall:

1. be in the prescribed Nomination Form (Form 1),
2. be endorsed by 25 signatures of eligible electors (Form 2)*;
3. be accompanied by a Declaration of Qualification;
4. be accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee (\$200.00 for Mayor and \$100.00 for all other offices, paid by cash, debit/credit card, certified cheque or money order payable to the Town).

*School Board Trustee candidates do not have to submit endorsement signatures.

Please note: No person who proposes to be a candidate may solicit or accept contributions for election purposes; or incur expenses, until that person has filed a nomination paper.
