Apply now to represent BWG on the Joint Compliance Audit Committee

The Towns of Bradford West Gwillimbury, Innisfil and New Tecumseth and the Townships of Adjala-Tosorontio and Essa have formed a Joint Compliance Audit Committee as required under the *Municipal Elections Act*. The committee consists of one representative from each of the participating municipalities. The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury is currently seeking a representative to serve on the committee for the 2018-2022 term.

The Joint Compliance Audit Committee is responsible for considering applications requesting audits of candidates' and third party advertisers' campaign finances. The committee may be required to appoint auditors and determine if legal proceedings are required as a result of the auditors' reports.

Applicants with a background in accounting, auditing, law, public administration or election administration are encouraged to apply. Applicants should also have knowledge of municipal campaign financing rules; excellent communication, analytical and decision making skills; experience working on a committee or task force or similar setting; and have flexibility to attend daytime or evening meetings.

Applicants cannot be Members of Council or employees of the participating municipalities, or candidates or registered third parties for the 2018 Municipal Election.

Members of the Committee will receive an honourarium of \$200 for attending a training session and \$200 plus mileage for committee meetings.

All interested applicants are encouraged to submit a letter of interest outlining your qualifications to the undersigned by August 10, 2018.
