

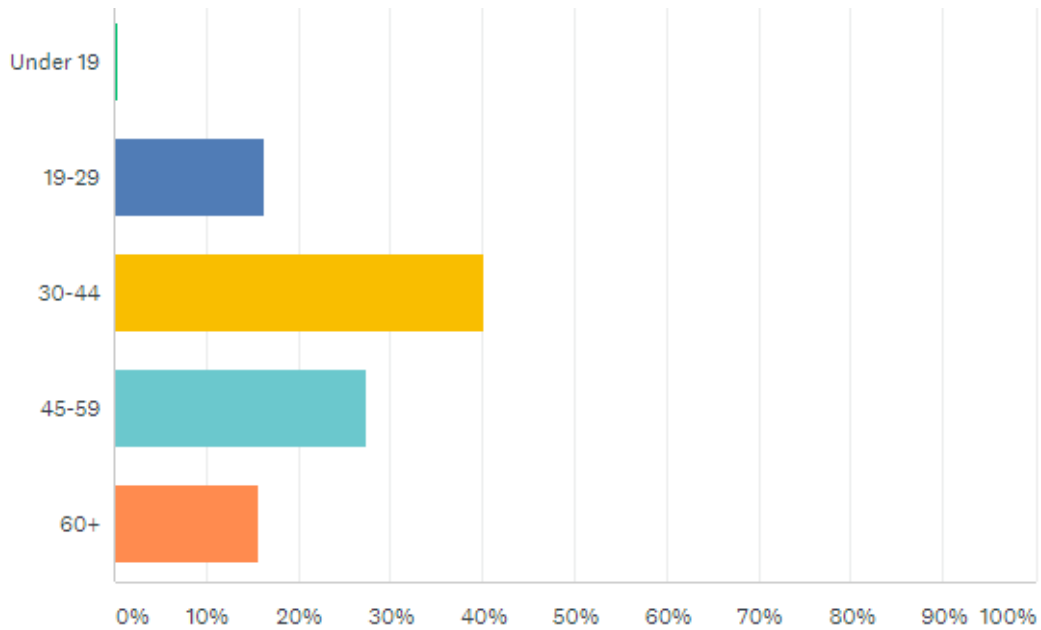

## What is your age?

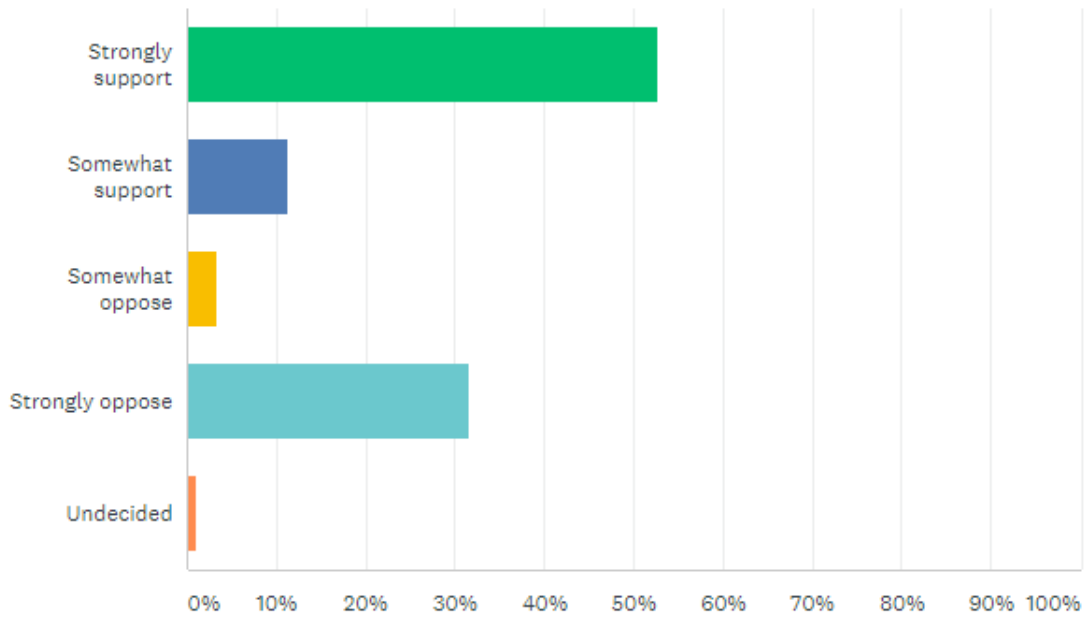

**To what degree do you support or oppose allowing recreational cannabis retail stores in the Town of BWG starting as soon as April 2019?**

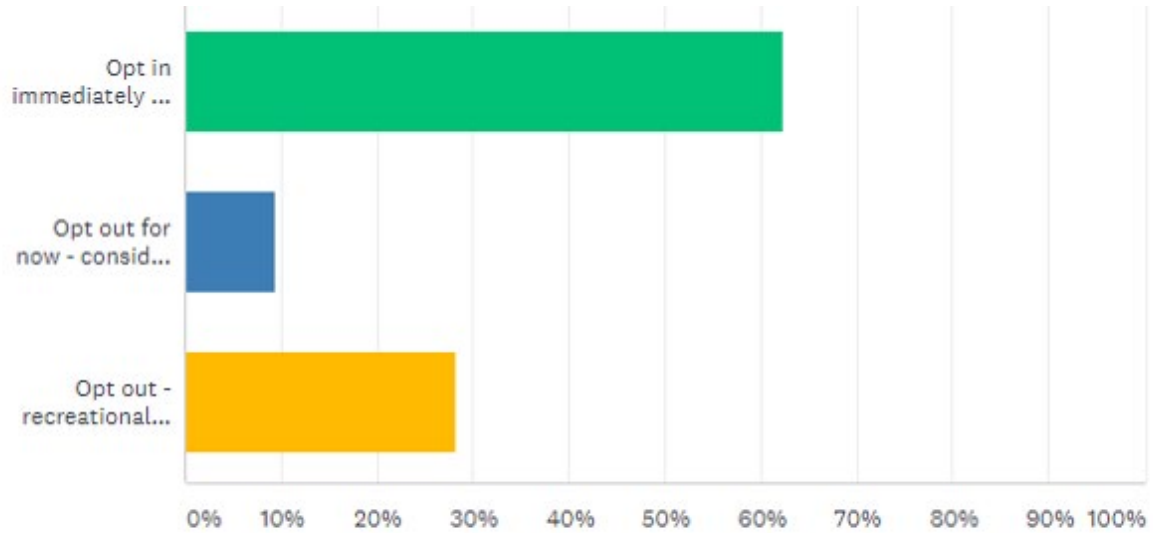

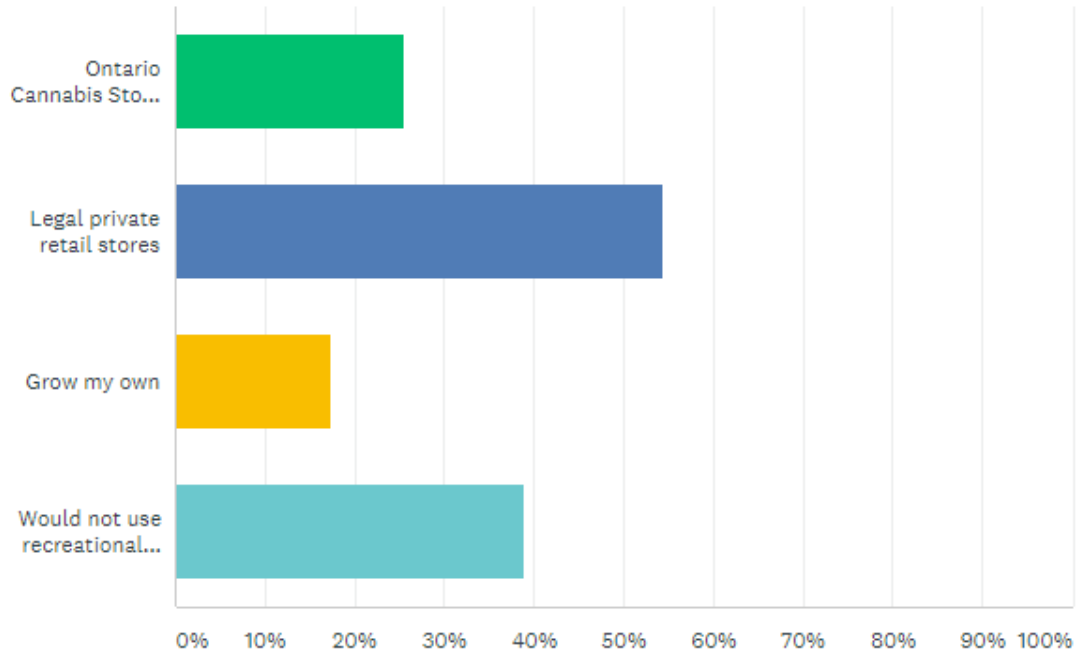


Summary:

▼ Opt in immediately - allow recreational cannabis retail stores in BWG beginning April 2019 (can NOT opt out later)	62.44% 394
▼ Opt out for now - consider opting in at a later date to allow recreational cannabis retail stores in BWG	9.35% 59
▼ Opt out - recreational cannabis stores should not be allowed in BWG	28.21% 178

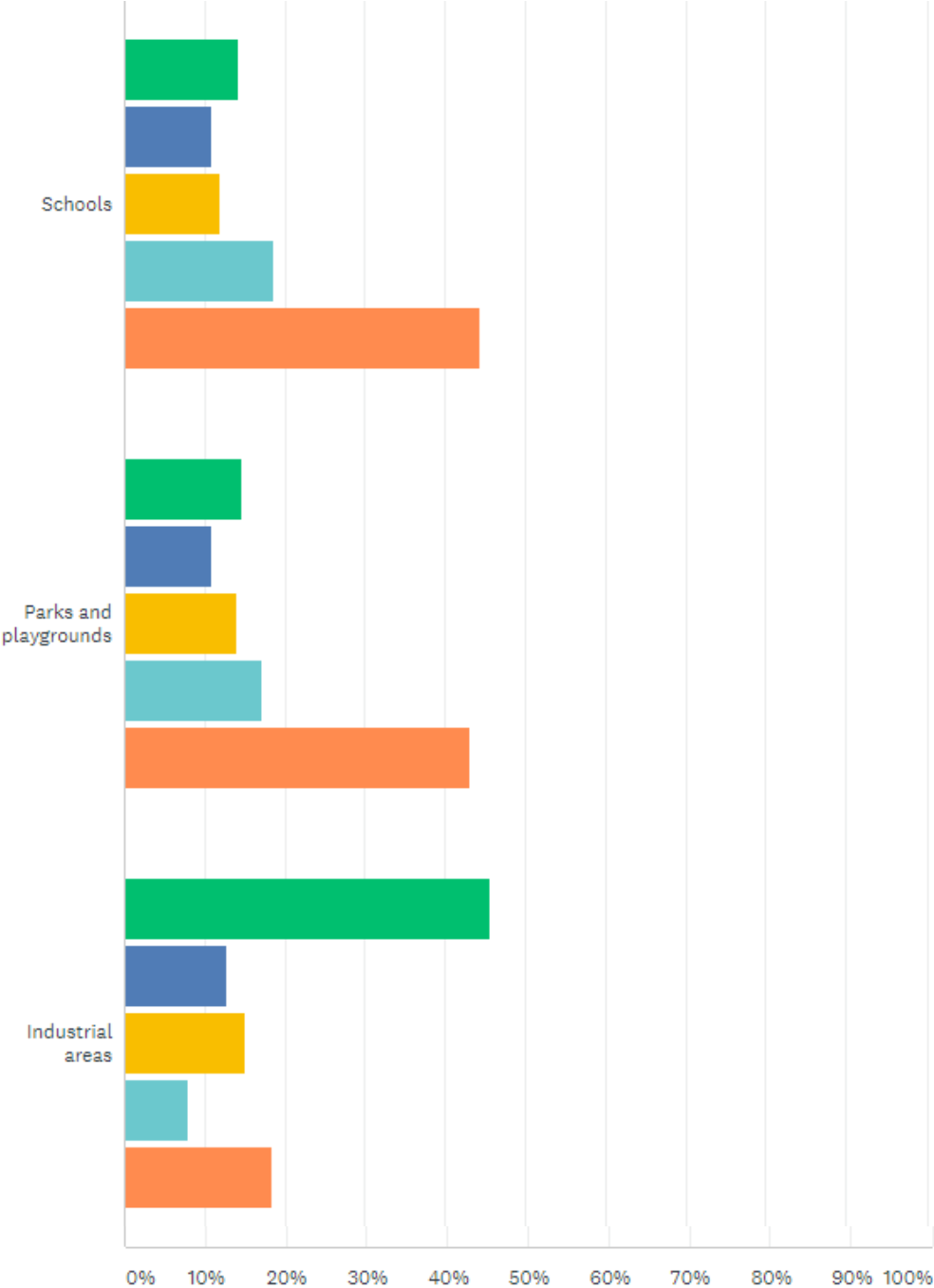

Please rate your level of concern with respect to having cannabis retail stores located in proximity to various locations in the community.

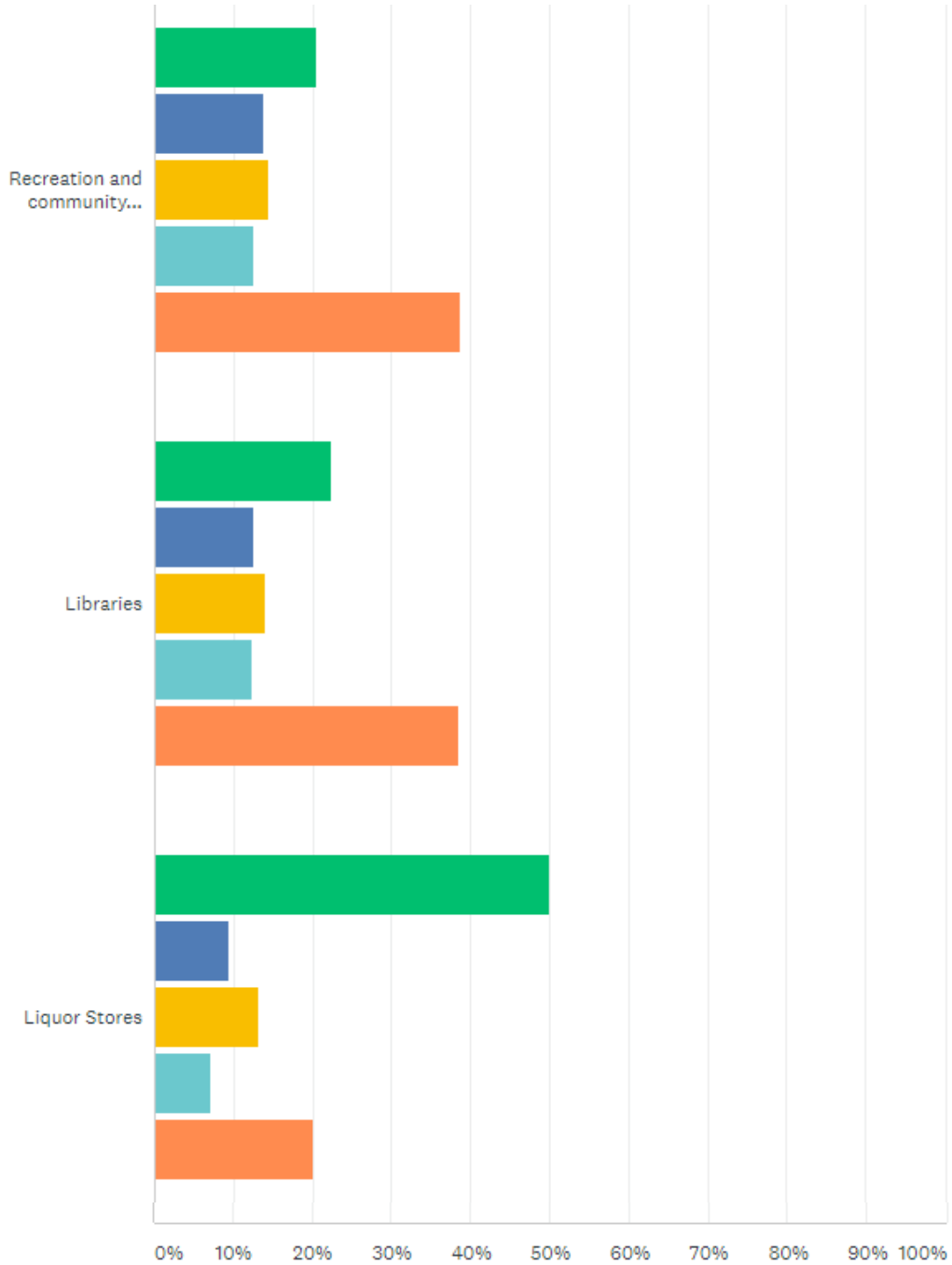

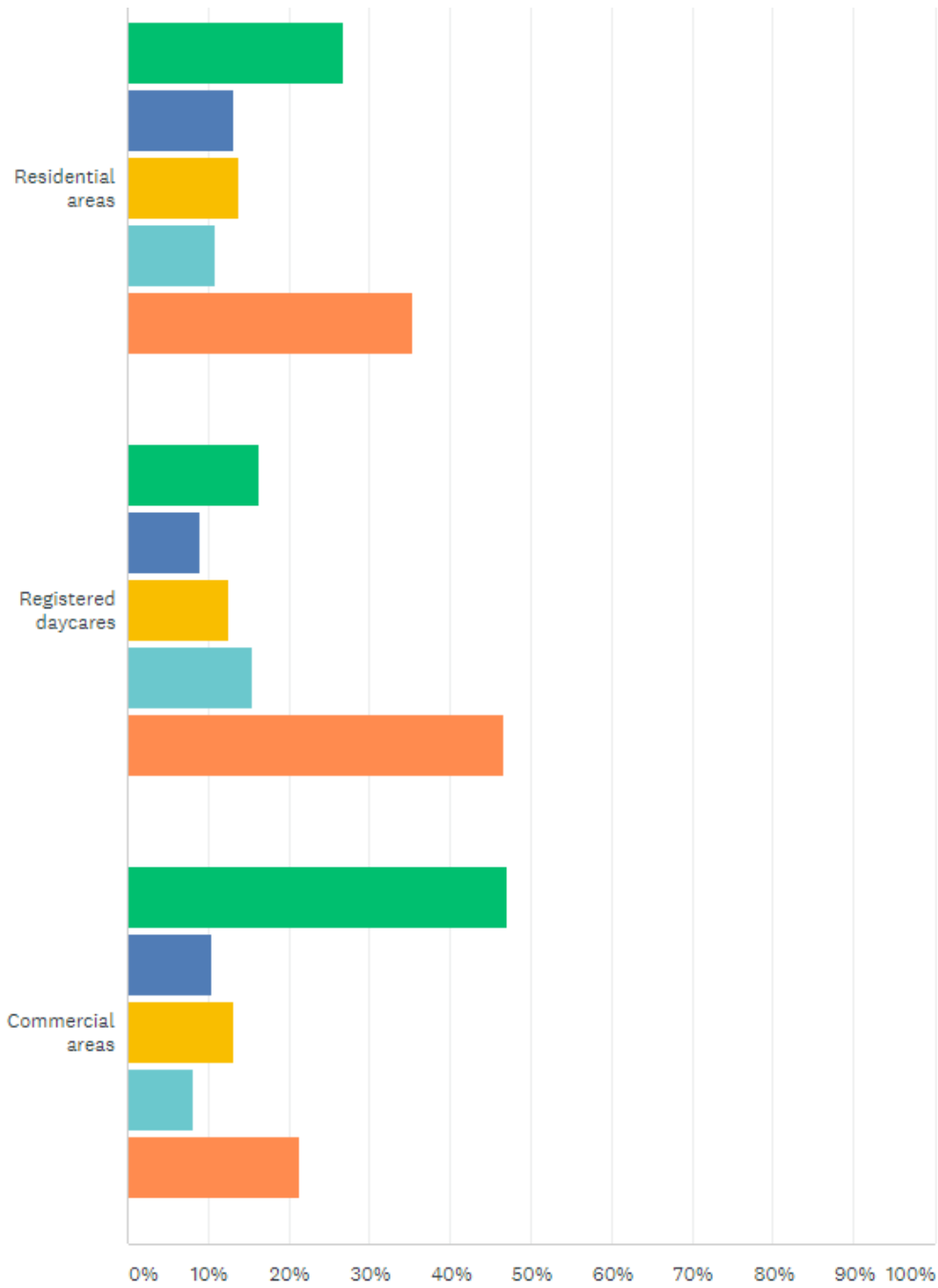

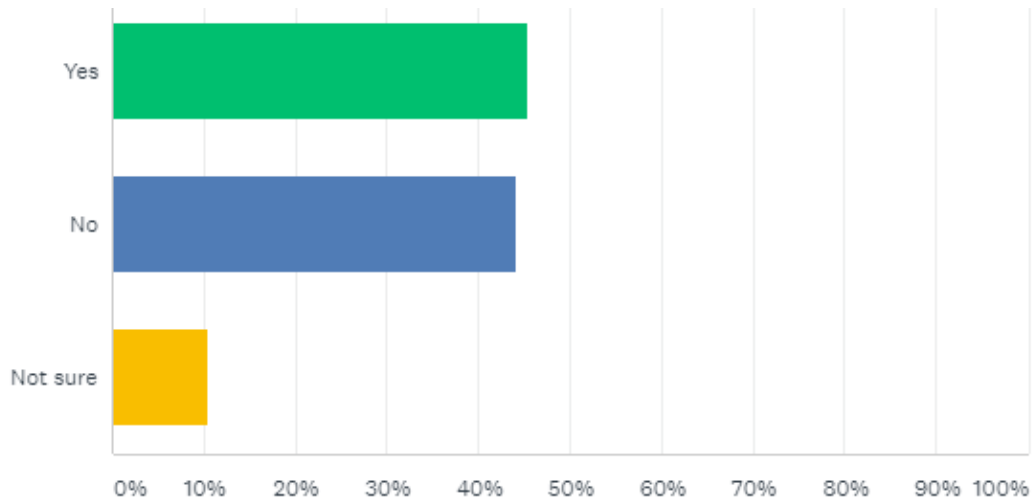
