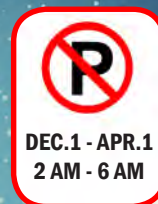

### WINTER PARKING RULES IN EFFECT IN BWG!



On-street parking is prohibited from December 1 through April 1 from 2:00-6:00 a.m. throughout BWG.

Parking is permitted for one additional hour (until 3:00 a.m.) at the downtown crossroads (Holland St. from Holland Crt. to Nelson St.; Simcoe Rd. S to Centre St.; Barrie St. N to John St.) to accommodate businesses that are open later.

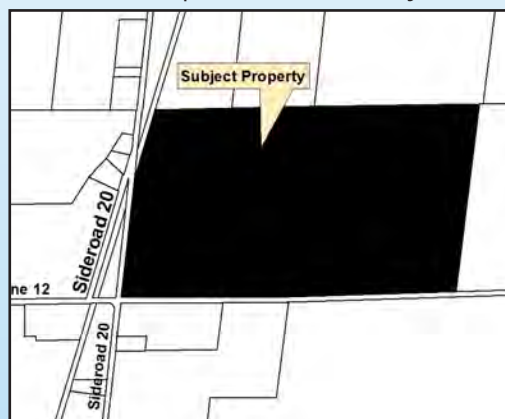
