## Notice of Complete Application and Public Meeting on a Proposed Zoning By-law Amendment

Pursuant to Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended

**Take notice** that the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury has received the following complete application:

**Owner:** Cachet Harbour Development (Dissette) Inc.  
**Location:** 200 Dissette Street

And take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury will be holding a public meeting on **Tuesday, June 5, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Zima Room of the BWG Library & Cultural Centre, 425 Holland Street West, Bradford**, to consider the proposed Zoning By-law amendment. (Please note that there may be more than one public meeting and that the matter will be dealt with in the order that it appears on the agenda.)

The owners are seeking to rezone the lands to the "Core Commercial (C1)" and "Residential Two (R2-2)" zones in order to permit the development of 7 blocks of back-to-back townhomes and 2 mixed-use blocks with ground floor commercial uses and upper floor residential uses, with site-specific performance standards. A key map showing the location of the lands is attached.

Additional information regarding the proposal is available for public inspection during regular office hours at the Office of Community Planning located at 305 Barrie Street, Unit 2, Bradford.

The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of the nature of the proposal, invite public input, and answer questions regarding the application.

Any person may attend the public meeting to make written or verbal representation in support of or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law amendment. If you wish to be notified of Council's decision regarding the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must submit a written request to Leigh Ann Penner at the address shown in the paragraph above.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the proposed Zoning By-law amendment is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the proposed zoning by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
