Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Line 8 Improvements

The Town of BWG is undertaking a study to prepare for improvements to Line 8. The full improvement area is Line 8 from Barrie Street to Sideroad 10, including Sideroad 10 from north of Line 8 to Reagens Industrial Parkway.

A Class Environmental Assessment will identify the necessary improvements and ideal configuration. The study will look at how best to meet the future transportation needs of BWG (roadway capacity, operational and safety deficiencies, intersection upgrades, extension of municipal services, drainage improvements and extension of active transportation facilities).

Public consultation is vital to the success of this study, so the Town wants to ensure that anyone interested can get involved and provide input. Please attend the Public Information Centre (PIC):
