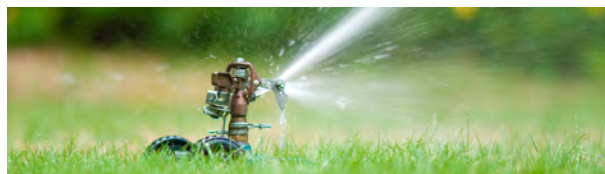

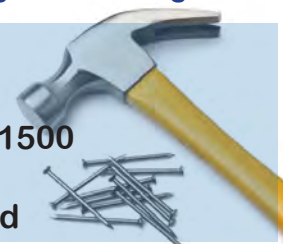

Call for Election Officials

The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury is recruiting for Election Officials to assist at the **Voter Help Centre** during the 2018 Municipal Election voting period from October 12-22. The election will be conducted using a telephone and internet voting method and there will be NO PAPER BALLOTS; therefore, voters do not need to go to a polling station to cast their vote.

What's involved in being an Election Official?

Election Officials' duties at the Voter Help Centre - located in the Zima Room of the BWG Public Library and Cultural Centre - will include greeting voters, directing voters to internet kiosks should they wish to vote on site, answering voters' questions, explaining the voting system, assisting with the voting process, making revisions to the Voters' List, utilizing voter management software, administering oaths and providing assistance to voters with disabilities. Voters who require assistance with the English-language voting system are permitted to bring their own interpreter to assist them with this process.

Who can apply to be an Election Official?

Applicants must be:

- at least 18 years of age;
- legally entitled to work in Canada;
- proficient with the use a computer in order to utilize voter management software; and
- available to attend a mandatory training session.

Previous election experience will be considered an asset. Applicants cannot be a candidate, or a spouse/relative of a candidate, or have a close personal or business relationship with a candidate.

How do I apply to be an Election Official?

Application forms are available on the Town's website or at the Town of BWG Administration Office at 100 Dissette Street, Units 7 & 8, open Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Please submit your application by August 24, 2018.

Confirming or adding yourself to the list to vote in the upcoming local election is quick and easy:

- Call 1-866-296-6722 or go to VoterLookUp.ca
- On the website, review the agreement then click I AGREE
- Enter your information - for municipality and street name, start typing then choose from the list of suggestions
- Confirm your listing or add yourself as a voter, and declare your preferred school board support
- You can also add other eligible voters in your household and/or family

Notice of the Passing of a Zoning By-Law

Pursuant to Sections 34 and 36 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended

Take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury passed By-law 2018-66 amending Zoning By-law 2010-050 on the 7th day of August, 2018 under sections 34 and 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, in respect of lands located in Part of Lot 15, Concession 5, being Block 184 on Registered Plan 51M-1137. A key map showing the location of the lands to which the by-law applies is set out below.

The purpose of By-law 2018-66 is to rezone the lands from the Future Development "FD" Zone to the Residential One Exception Holding "R1-2*9(H6)" to permit the development of five (5) single detached dwellings. The Holding (H6) symbol will not be removed until it is confirmed that the applicable terms of the Subdivision Agreement have been complied with as they relate to the new lots. The complete by-law is available for public inspection during regular office hours at the Office of Community Planning, 305 Barrie Street, Unit 2, Bradford.

Any person or public body may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal (LPAT) in respect of Council's decision by filing with Rebecca Murphy, Clerk, of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, 100 Dissette Street, Units 7 & 8, P.O. Box 100, Bradford, Ontario, L3Z 2A7, **not later than the 5th day of September, 2018**, a notice of appeal which must set out the reasons for the appeal and must be accompanied by the LPAT form and fee of \$300.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.

In conformity with section 34(18) of the Planning Act, public comments/submissions and response to same are set out in Report No. DES 2018 28 which is available for viewing on the municipal website at <https://bit.ly/2AYPTaj> or by contacting the Office of Community Planning at planninginfo@townofbwg.com.

Only individuals, corporations, and public bodies may appeal a zoning by-law to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf. If you wish to appeal to the LPAT, the appeal forms are available from the LPAT website at www.elto.gov.on.ca.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the By-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury or, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
