Zoning By-law Amendments Proposed for Home Occupations, Central Air Conditioner Setbacks

All are welcome at the Public Meeting on October 2

The Town of BWG has initiated the process to make two zoning by-law amendments.

The first is to permit and regulate specific types of home occupations including outdoor swimming lessons, tutoring and music lessons, online sales, fitness instruction, medical practices and catering. Additionally, storage, selling of goods, use of accessory buildings, rules and administrative updates will be addressed.

The second is to reduce the minimum side-yard setback required for central air conditioners in residential zones. This amendment will reduce the minimum distance an air conditioning unit must be from the side property line from 1.2 metres to 0.6 metres.

To give the public and members of council opportunity to hear the application and make comments, a public meeting will take place at the Town Council meeting on:
