SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS on BWG Transit

Due to reduced levels of ridership in keeping with current recommendations for preventing the spread of COVID-19, the following adjustments are being made to BWG Transit service until further notice.

BWG Transit



From March 24 through 28:

- Route 2B will no longer be in service
- Weekday service hours on Routes 1 and 2B will be reduced to 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Saturday service on Route 1 ONLY (no Route 2 service) 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Starting March 30:

- Service will be available on demand only. If you require a ride, call 905-775-7770 and provide your stop number. You will be given a timeframe for pick-up.
- Service will be available on weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Transit is FREE for all riders during this period.

We appreciate everyone limiting their bus trips to essential rides only, staying home if feeling ill, and continuing to follow the guidelines for social distancing (2 metre distance). We will continue to conduct extra sanitization of common touch points.
