- Playgrounds and sports areas (e.g. basketball courts) are closed. Please respect provincial restrictions on gatherings.

### Financial relief for residents impacted by COVID-19

At a Special Meeting of Council on March 26, Council passed a by-law to provide financial relief to residents to ease stress as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

This includes extending property tax due dates by 60 days for each remaining payment in 2020. All pre-authorized payments will be deducted 60 days later than usual. There is also a 90-day grace period on payment of water/wastewater utility bills with no penalties and interest.

### OPEN AIR BURN BAN IN EFFECT

Open air fires in Bradford West Gwillimbury are banned effective immediately in order to reduce the risk of preventable fires and reduce the strain on emergency services.

All burn permits are canceled until further notice, and no new permits will be issued.

The ban applies throughout the municipality of Bradford West Gwillimbury, and prohibits all open air burning including burn barrels, fire pits, outdoor wood-burning appliances like chimineas and outdoor fireplaces, as well as campfires. Only propane and natural gas barbeques and fire pits are permitted for the cooking of food.

Service on all routes is available ON DEMAND only until further notice.

- If you require a ride, call 905-775-7770 and provide your stop number. You will be given a timeframe for pick-up.
- Service is available on weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

## Notice of Complete Application for a Temporary Use Zoning By-law Amendment

Pursuant to Section 34(10.4) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended

**Take notice** that the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury has received the following application to amend Zoning By-law 2010-050:

**Owner:** Roseau Capital Corporation, c/o DG Group  
**Location:** 3778 County Road 88

The applicant has applied for a Temporary Use Zoning By-law amendment to permit the establishment of a new homes sales pavilion on the property for a three (3) year period. A key map showing the location of the lands is set out below.

Prior to Council making a determination respecting the above-noted application, there will be at least one Public Meeting to give the public an opportunity to make representation. The date of the Public Meeting has not yet been determined. Notice of the Public Meeting will be given at least 20 days before the meeting is held, by way of notice in this newspaper and in accordance with the provisions of the Planning Act.

If a person or public body does not make oral submission at the Public Meeting or make written submission to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the passing or refusal of the Zoning By-law amendment, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, and the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
