## Quarantining of Material



## Notice of Complete Application and Public Meeting for a Proposed Zoning By-law Amendment

Pursuant to Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury will be holding a public meeting electronically on **Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at 7:00 pm** to consider the proposed amendment to Zoning By-law 2010-050, as amended.

Please note that there may be more than one public meeting and that the matter will be dealt with in the order that it appears on the agenda.

The purpose and effect of the proposed amendment is to permit a roofing company (contractor's yard) on the subject property.

The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of the nature of the proposal, invite public input, and answer questions regarding the application.

Any person may make a submission in support of or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law amendment. Please see the "Protocol for Electronic Participation in Meetings of Council" for participation in the Public Meeting if you wish to make an oral submission. If you are unable to make written submissions and therefore wish to make an oral statement during the meeting please email [clerk@townofbwg.com](mailto:clerk@townofbwg.com) prior to noon on October 13, 2020 to register. You will be provided further instructions on how you will connect during the virtual meeting. All oral statements will be recorded as part of the electronic meeting and will be posted for public viewing on [www.youtube.com/c/TownofBradfordWestGwillimbury](http://www.youtube.com/c/TownofBradfordWestGwillimbury).

If you wish to be notified of Council's decision regarding the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must submit a written request to Thomas Dysart at the address shown in the paragraph above.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the proposed Zoning By-law amendment is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal and the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
