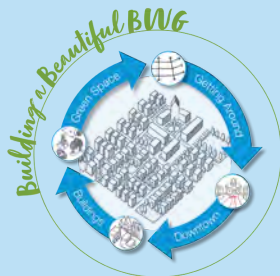

Nominations are being accepted in the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury for the office of:

Ward 2 COUNCILLOR (1 Councillor Elected)

Any eligible voter in Bradford West Gwillimbury may run. The candidate filing fee is \$100. Fees must be paid by cash, certified cheque, money order, debit or credit card.

A nomination must be certified by the Clerk before such person becomes a certified candidate for the office to which they are nominated. No person who proposes to be a candidate may solicit or accept contributions for the purpose of the election or incur campaign expenses until that person has filed a Nomination Paper with the Clerk.
