### Notice of Registration of Third Party Advertisers

Please take note of the following with regards to the Town of BWG 2020 Ward 2 By-election as per the *Municipal Elections Act*:

88.6 (1) An individual, corporation or trade union may, in person or by an agent, file with the clerk of the municipality responsible for conducting an election a notice of registration to be a registered third party for the election, and the notice must be filed in the prescribed form and must include a declaration of qualification signed by the individual or by a representative of the corporation or trade union, as the case may be. 2016, c. 15, s. 49.

And take note:

(8) In the case of a by-election for an office, the notice of registration cannot be filed earlier than the first day for filing nominations under subsection 65 (4) and cannot be filed later than the last day on which the clerk's office is open before voting day, at a time when the clerk's office is open. 2016, c. 15, s. 49.

Registration must be done in person or by agent by appointment at the Administration Centre, located on 100 Dissette Street, Units 7 & 8. Registration is open from September 16, 2020 to December 4, 2020, during regular office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). Appointments are encouraged to ensure safe physical distancing - call 905-775-5366.

The purpose and effect of the proposed amendment is to permit a "Day Nursery" on the subject property.

If you wish to be notified of Council's decision regarding the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must submit a written request to Brandon Slopack at the address shown in the paragraph above.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the proposed Zoning By-law amendment is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal and the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
