Take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, at its Committee of the Whole meeting on December 1, 2020, intends to consider a motion to amend Procedural By-law 2013-20, as amended, a by-law to provide rules governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings of Council, local boards and committees and the conduct of its members. The proposed amendments provide for electronic participation in Council, committee and board meetings outside of a declared emergency, as well as updates to provide greater clarity of procedural rules and definitions and to reflect current administrative processes.

The Committee of the Whole meeting will be held during the Regular Council meeting that begins at 7:00 p.m. and is held electronically. AND TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury will be holding a public meeting electronically on **Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 7:00 pm** to consider the proposed amendment to Zoning By-law 2010-050, as amended. **The Council meeting will be streamed live on the Town's YouTube channel at www.youtube.com/c/TownofBradfordWestGwillimbury.** Please note that there may be more than one public meeting and that the matter will be dealt with in the order that it appears on the agenda.

The purpose and effect of the proposed zoning by-law amendment is to rezone the subject property from the Residential One "R1-1" and Residential One Exception "R1-1*8" Zones to the Institutional "I" Zone to permit an elementary school on the subject lands.

The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of the nature of the proposal, invite public input, and answer questions regarding the application.

If you are unable to make written submissions and therefore wish to make an oral statement during the meeting please email clerk@townofbwg.com prior to noon on February 9, 2021 to register. You will be provided further instructions on how you will connect during the virtual meeting. All oral statements will be recorded as part of the electronic meeting and will be posted for public viewing on www.youtube.com/c/TownofBradfordWestGwillimbury.

If you wish to be notified of Council's decision regarding the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must submit a written request to Thomas Dysart at the address shown in the paragraph above.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the proposed Zoning By-law amendment is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal and the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
