Notice of Decision to Grant Draft Approval for a Plan of Subdivision

Pursuant to Section 51 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended

Take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury granted draft plan approval to Plan of Subdivision D12-19-04, Bradford East Developments Inc., on the 17th day of November, 2020 under section 51 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, in respect of lands located in Part of Lot 15, Concession 5, being Block 170 on Registered Plan 51M-1137. A key map showing the location of the lands is shown below.

The purpose and effect of the Draft Plan of Subdivision is to subdivide the subject property to permit a residential development consisting of 29 street townhouse units. The proposed Plan of Subdivision has been granted draft approval subject to the fulfilment of conditions.

Council's decision, the proposed plan of subdivision and conditions of approval are available for public inspection by contacting by contacting the Office of Community Planning at planninginfo@townofbwg.com.

Any person or public body may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal in respect of Council's decision by filing a notice of appeal with Rebecca Murphy, Clerk, of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, 100 Dissette Street, P.O. Box 100, Bradford, Ontario, L3Z 2A7, **which must be received no later than December 16, 2020**. The notice of appeal must set out the reasons for the appeal and must be accompanied by the LPAT form (available from the LPAT website at www.elto.gov.on.ca) and fee of \$1,100.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.

In conformity with section 51(38) of the Planning Act, public comments/submissions and response to same are set out in Report No. DES 2020 57 which is available for viewing on the municipal website at <https://bit.ly/390jakF> or by contacting the Office of Community Planning at planninginfo@townofbwg.com.

The applicant or any public body may, at any time before the approval of the final plan of subdivision, appeal any of the conditions imposed by the Town of BWG to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal by filing with the Town a notice of appeal.

The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, as the approval authority, may in its discretion, change the conditions of the approval of the proposed plan of subdivision at any time before the approval of the final plan.

You will be entitled to receive notice of any changes to the conditions of approval of the proposed plan of subdivision if you have made a written request to be notified of the changes to the conditions.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal regarding any changes to the conditions of approval unless the person or public body, before the approval authority made its decision, made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the approval authority, or made a written request to be notified of the changes to the conditions or, in the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal's opinion, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

Only individuals, corporations, or public bodies may appeal decisions in respect of a proposed plan of subdivision to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal of the decision of the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, including the lapsing provisions or the conditions, unless the person or public body, before the decision of the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council, or made a written request to be notified of changes to the conditions or, in the Tribunal's opinion, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

Notice of the Passing of a Temporary Use By-Law

Pursuant to Section 34(18) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended

Take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury passed By-law 2020-104 amending Zoning By-law 2010-050 on the 17th day of November, 2020 under sections 34, 36 and 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, in respect of the lands municipally known as 3651 Line 6. A key map showing the location of the lands to which the by-law applies is attached.

The purpose of By-law 2020-104 is to permit an "Aggregate Processing Facility", "Aggregate Transfer Station", "Contractors Yard", "Accessory Outdoor Storage" on the lands along with accessory office space (for the permitted uses) and retail sales of salvaged materials from within the existing dwelling for a three (3) year period. The Holding "(H1)" symbol will be removed once the development agreement has been executed. Any person or public body may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal in respect of Council's decision by filing a notice of appeal with Rebecca Murphy, Clerk, of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, 100 Dissette Street, P.O. Box 100, Bradford, Ontario, L3Z 2A7, **which must be received no later than December 16, 2020**. The notice of appeal must set out the reasons for the appeal and must be accompanied by the LPAT form (available from the LPAT website at www.elto.gov.on.ca) and fee of \$1,100.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.

In conformity with section 34(18) of the Planning Act, public comments/submissions and response to same are set out in Report No. DES 2020 59 which is available for viewing on the municipal website at <https://bit.ly/38QhxWx> or by contacting the Office of Community Planning at planninginfo@townofbwg.com.

Only individuals, corporations, and public bodies may appeal a zoning by-law to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the By-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury or, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
