TOYS for TICKETS

Turn Scrooge into Santa by paying your ticket in **TOYS!**

If you receive a ticket from December 1st to 14th for parking on the street during the winter overnight ban, you can “pay” the ticket by donating toys worth at least as much as the amount of the fine.

The toy must be new, unwrapped and in its original packaging, and the store receipt showing the item and dollar amount must be provided. **Toys must be purchased at a store in BWG.**

Bring your ticket and toy to the Town of BWG office at 100 Dissette St., Unit 7&8, by **December 17, 2020.**

WINTER PARKING RULES IN EFFECT IN BWG!



On-street parking is prohibited from December 1 through April 1 from 2:00-6:00 a.m. throughout BWG.

Parking is permitted for one additional hour (until 3:00 a.m.) at the downtown crossroads (Holland St. from Holland Crt. to Nelson St.; Simcoe Rd. S to Centre St.; Barrie St. N to John St.) to accommodate businesses that are open later.

Vehicles also may not park blocking or overhanging the sidewalk or street.

Violators may be ticketed or towed.
