# PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

## URBAN LANEWAYS

The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury is looking to make some changes to the designations and classifications of “urban laneways” in Town in order to improve the safety and condition of these roads and to ensure they receive an appropriate level of service.

For many of the laneways, levels of service will not change; however, each laneway is different in its design and purpose so the following options will be considered:

- Where access to the laneways is already limited, the designation may be changed from “public highway” to “public space”.
- Speed limit may be reduced.
- Laneways may be designated as one-way.

The Town is holding a public meeting to provide residents living or backing on one of laneways (as highlighted on the attached map) with an opportunity to review the proposed changes in more detail, as well as provide feedback to the Town.
