

NOTICE OF WORK

ASPHALT PAVING

Due to unforeseen issues with the asphalt manufacturing plant, paving will not be taking place as scheduled on Friday, July 24th. Paving work is tentatively re-scheduled for the week of July 27th to July 31st. Additional details are as follows:

WHERE:

Work will be taking place to complete the asphalt paving at the following locations:

1. **Queen Street** – between Essa Road and Toronto Street
2. **Maplegrove Avenue** – from Collings Avenue to Catania Avenue
3. **Catania Avenue** – from Maplegrove Avenue to Simcoe Road

WHEN:

The Contractor is scheduled to begin the installation of asphalt paving during the week of July 27th to the 31st, weather permitting. The entire project is expected to take approximately two days to complete.

WHAT:

The work involves the installation and compaction of a new hot-mix asphalt road surface.

HOW YOU MAY BE AFFECTED:

Access to driveways may be temporarily obstructed during the asphalt paving process, and homeowners are requested not to park on the newly paved road for 24-hours to allow the asphalt enough time to consolidate and cool.
