## Innisfil Water Treatment Plant Upgrades

June 28, 2018

### WHAT'S HAPPENING:

Upgrades are being made to the Innisfil Lakeshore Water Treatment Plant (WTP) in order to serve the growing populations of both Innisfil and Bradford West Gwillimbury. During the course of the summer, several brief shut-downs will take place at the WTP for the switch over to the new system.

### HOW YOU MAY BE AFFECTED:

Proactive measures may be taken to ensure we have a more-than-adequate water supply for regular needs as well as emergency uses. The WTP is only one of two sources of tap water in BWG so shortages are unlikely; however, if there are other stressors on the system, such as if the weather is hot and dry during the shutdown, the Town may restrict certain non-essential uses of water.

IF WATER RESTRICTIONS ARE REQUIRED, residents will receive 72 hours' notice via methods including Facebook, the Town's website and local news media. Level 1 restrictions (as per Town of BWG By-law 2014-17) would be in place for approximately 24-48 hours.

Level 1 mandatory restrictions are:

- No lawn watering
- No car washing

If you are able to postpone other non-essential outdoor water use (such as recreational sprinkler use, pool filling, etc.) during restriction periods, we appreciate your efforts to do so.

Please note that restrictions are NOT in place yet, but keep an eye on the media mentioned above for updates throughout the next several weeks. Thank you for your cooperation and patience during this work.
