## **WATER RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE** **August 9, 2018**

Last month, we notified residents of the work going on to upgrade the Innisfil Lakeshore Water Treatment Plant (WTP), and two brief shutdowns took place. Thank you to all for your cooperation during these events.

We have been advised that the WTP will be shut down on August 9 for what is expected to be the final time during this project. Once this work is completed, the capacity of the plant will be nearly double, ensuring an adequate supply for the future growth of both BWG and Innisfil.

To ensure that the supply of water for everyday and emergency uses is not impacted, the following water restrictions will be put in place:

**On Thursday, August 9 from 7:00 a.m. until 11:59 p.m., the following non-essential water uses are prohibited:**

- lawn watering\***
- car washing**

(\*exceptions will continue to be permitted as per the by-law for new sod, seed, etc.)

If you are able to voluntarily postpone other non-essential outdoor water use (such as recreational sprinkler use, pool filling, etc.) during the restriction period, we appreciate your efforts to do so.
