



# Inflow and Infiltration Study

Sanitary maintenance chamber inspections and installation of flow monitoring devices

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October 7, 2020

## What/Where:

The Town has commenced an inflow and infiltration study project. The goal is to reduce the amount of rainwater entering the sanitary sewage system.

One of our goals is to determine where the rainwater enters the system. GM Blue Plan, the Town's consultant, will begin the inspection of sanitary maintenance chambers within the urban area. This assessment will determine suitable locations for the installation of 20 flow-monitoring devices. These flow monitors will be in place for one year.

## When:

The inspection will commence on Wednesday, October 7, 2020, weather pending. We anticipate GMBP will complete the assessment and installations by Friday October 30, 2020.

## How you may be affected:

These works will take place both on and off the roadways. The roads will remain open and access to properties facilitated at all times.

You may experience minor delays as GMBP works through the areas. The consultant will have the appropriate traffic control throughout their work zone.
