

Inflow and Infiltration Study

Sanitary maintenance chamber inspections

October 30, 2020

What/Where:

The Town has commenced an inflow and infiltration study project. The goal is to reduce the amount of rainwater entering the sanitary sewage system.

One of our goals is to determine where the rainwater enters the system. 'Pipetek' on behalf of GM BluePlan, the Town's consultant, will begin the inspection and condition assessment of all sanitary maintenance chambers within the urban area. This assessment involves capturing images and data for each maintenance chamber. The data collected will provide the Town with the current condition of our infrastructure.

When:

The inspection and condition assessment will commence on Monday, November 2, 2020. We anticipate that Pipetek will complete their works by March 2021.

How you may be affected:

These works will take place both on and off the roadways. The roads will remain open and access to properties facilitated at all times.

You may experience minor delays as Pipetek works through the areas. The consultant will have the appropriate traffic control throughout their work zone.
