

2021 Urban Roads Rehab Pre-Construction Notice

May 4, 2021

WHAT:

The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury is about to upgrade the road, sidewalk, watermains, and sewers in certain areas of Bradford. The project area will be on the following streets.

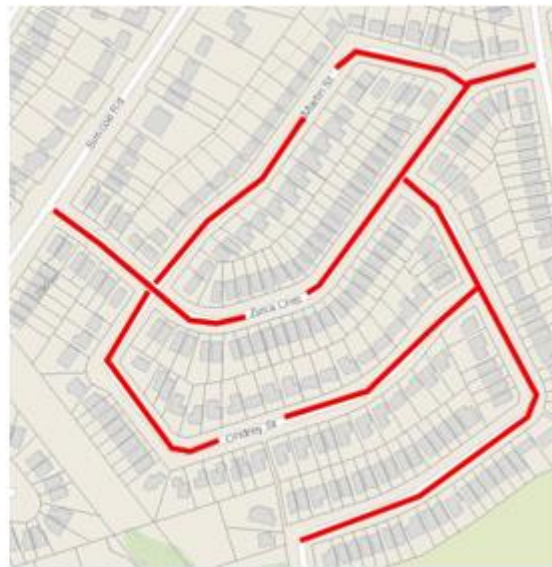

Construction will take place between May and December 2021, and between April and August 2022. A more specific schedule will be distributed once there is a contractor engaged.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION:

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water, and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.

- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the project.
- Work in the boulevard in front of homes and commercial properties is expected. This work includes removing and replacing driveways within the Town's property limits, municipal sidewalks, and grassed boulevards, where necessary.
- Property owners should remove items located within the Town property limits (boulevard), such as landscaping and or decorative fencing or objects, before work starts. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard, please contact the staff listed below.

HOW YOU MAY BE AFFECTED:

General traffic and water supply:

- All roads will remain open throughout the project. There will be traffic detours around construction zones and some delays. Occasionally, we may restrict access to driveways for short periods. This will be to facilitate the road, sidewalk, and curb construction works in front of your home. In these instances, we will work directly with you to facilitate access to your home and parking alternatives.
- There may be a disruption to your water supply. In this event, we will send out a notice at least 24 hours before the disruption.

Residents within the construction area:

- **WASTE COLLECTION:**
Waste collection will continue. Please write your house number on your garbage, recycling, and compost bins. This will ensure collection and return to you every week during construction.
- **PERMISSION TO ENTER:** The project also includes grading and restoration of the boulevard at various properties. Should your property be impacted, you will receive a separate request to grant the Town permission to enter your property to complete the work.
- **ACCOMMODATION:** Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the **staff below** to arrange for access during the construction period.

This project is yet to be awarded. The Town will act as the Contract Administrator, conduct daily site inspections, and be the main contact during the works.
