



South West Quadrant Roads: Temporary Water Interruption & After Hours Work Notice

November 14, 2018

WHEN:

This letter is to advise the affected residents and businesses that there will be construction operations on Friday November 16, 2018 between the hours of 1:00am and 7:00am. The reason for the work happening throughout the early morning is to minimize the water service disruption to nearby businesses and residents.

Should the operation be postponed due to weather the make up date will be Monday November 19, 2018 from 1:00am to 7:00am.

WHERE:

The focus of the work will be limited to the intersection of Collings Avenue and Maplegrove Avenue. This work will require the municipal water service to be shut down on Collings Avenue between Holland Street and Maplegrove Avenue. This will only affect the commercial buildings. The residential homes in the area will NOT have a disruption to their water service.

WHAT:

The type of work that will take place involves the connection of the new watermain to the existing watermain network. This type of work will require the municipal water to be temporarily shut down in order for the Town's contractor to safely perform the installation.

The work will entail typical construction noise. The contractor will take every effort to minimize the construction noise.
