Qualifications: To be eligible to participate you must be at least **16 years old**, possess your Standard First Aid and CPR-C certification and have the following qualifications:

Instructor:

- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Lifesaving Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Emergency First Aid Instructor

Lifeguard:

- Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard

Qualifications: To be eligible to participate you must be at least **15 years old**, possess your Standard First Aid and CPR-C certification and have the following qualifications:

Assistant Instructor/Aquatic Attendant:

- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross (or higher)

Candidates must meet the minimum age requirements to apply to these positions and hold current certifications or show proof that they will have completed these certifications prior to the start of the summer session on Monday, July 2nd, 2019. All applicants will be required to complete a Vulnerable Sector Screening/Police Information Check upon hire.

The hourly rate for the Instructor is \$16.50; Lifeguard is \$15.00; Assistant Instructor and Aquatic Attendant is \$14.00.
