



Yoga Instructor (Part-time)

The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury's Leisure Centre includes two NHL sized ice rinks, a gymnasium, community program rooms, fitness centre and a state of the art aquatics centre with an eight lane competitive/lap pool, leisure pool with aquatic features and a relaxation/therapy pool. The Leisure Services division is looking for an energetic, highly motivated and organized individual to join the Fitness team.

Reporting to the Fitness Supervisor, the Yoga Instructor will provide direct leadership to maintain group fitness class continuity and provides a superior experience to our members in program areas. This role will plan, organize and instruct classes for all ages and abilities while creating and maintain a safe, clean and comfortable environment for participants. This role is also responsible for ensuring that group fitness equipment is cleaned up after each class and identifies and reports maintenance and repairs to equipment as required.

The Yoga Instructor will have a Yoga Alliance recognized certification or equivalent. Additional specialty training in Restorative Yoga, Pre-natal Yoga, Kids Yoga, Teen Yoga and Mommy & Baby Yoga is considered an asset. Preferred candidates must have significant experience in the delivery of group fitness classes and be able to instruct a safe class for all levels of participants. Formal academic training in Recreation Leadership, Kinesiology, Physical Education or a related field is considered an asset. The successful candidates will have proven interpersonal and relationship building skills and the ability to establish rapport and excellent communication with members, guests, staff and volunteers. Candidates must be able to promote a culture of inclusiveness and work with a diverse population of employees and the general public. Candidates will have current Standard First Aid, and CPR Level C certifications. Candidates must have morning, evening and weekend availability, be available to work flexible hours as part of regular schedule or for meetings, and/or special events and be comfortable teaching outdoor classes. All applicants will be required to complete a Vulnerable Sector Screening.

This position offers an hourly wage of \$25.30 to \$29.80.
