Qualifications: To be eligible to participate you must be at least **16 years old**, possess your Standard First Aid and CPR-C certification and have the following qualifications:

Instructor:

- Lifesaving Swim instructor
- Lifesaving Society Lifesaving Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Emergency First Aid Instructor

Lifeguard:

- Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard

Qualifications: To be eligible to participate you must be at least **15 years old**, possess your Standard First Aid and CPR-C certification and have the following qualifications:

Assistant Instructor/Aquatic Attendant:

- Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor
- Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross (or higher)

Candidates must meet the minimum age requirements to apply to these positions and hold current certifications or show proof that they will have completed these certifications prior to the start of the Winter Session on Tuesday, December 13, 2022. Candidates must be able to promote a culture of inclusiveness and work with a diverse population of employees, participants, agencies and the public. All applicants will be required to complete a Vulnerable Sector Screening/Police Information Check upon hire along with proof confirming receipt of the full series of a Covid-19 vaccine as a condition of hire in accordance with the Town's mandatory vaccination policy.

The hourly rate for the Instructor is \$19.03; Lifeguard is \$16.22; Assistant Instructor and Aquatic Attendant is \$15.50.
