WATER RESTRICTIONS IN PLACE **July 4, 2018**

Last week, the Town of BWG described the work going on to upgrade the Innisfil Lakeshore Water Treatment Plant (WTP).

We have been advised that the WTP will be shut down on July 4 to allow for the necessary work.

To ensure that the shutdown, in combination with ongoing hot, dry weather, does not affect the adequate supply of water for everyday and emergency uses, the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury is now advising that water restrictions will be put in place as described below.

On Wednesday, July 4 from 7:00 a.m. until 11:59 p.m., the following non-essential water uses are prohibited:

- lawn watering**
- car washing**

If you are able to voluntarily postpone other non-essential outdoor water use (such as recreational sprinkler use, pool filling, etc.) during the restriction period, we appreciate your efforts to do so.

There may be further shutdowns and/or restrictions during the WTP upgrades this summer. Please refer back to this page for updates.
