

2017 Urban Roads Spring Start-up

April 23, 2018

WHAT:

The Town of BWG will recommence road rehabilitation works on Britannia Avenue, Nelson Avenue, Cambridge Crescent, Porter Street, Kneeshaw Place, and Scanlon Avenue shortly.

WHEN:

The contractor will begin to mobilize on site towards the end of April/beginning of May. The balance of the work will take approximately two months.

WHERE:

The work will take place throughout the area along the roadways mentioned above. Every effort will be taken to minimize disruption as much as possible. At times, there may be lane restrictions within the immediate area of the work zones. However, the roads will be open and access to homes facilitated at all times.

WHY:

The restoration phase of the project includes the following type of work:

- Top soil and sod deficiency work
- Driveway and walkway restoration
- Paving the roads with the final layer of asphalt (later in the summer)
- Rehabilitation of the sanitary sewer on Scanlon Avenue. This will not require extensive excavation.
- Adjust maintenance holes
- Curb work behind the catchbasins
- Various other remedial deficiency work
