



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE (PIC) No. 1  
Line 8 Improvements from Barrie Street to Sideroad 10 and  
Sideroad 10 from north of Line 8 to Reagens Industrial Parkway  
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**

**The Study**

Planmac Engineering Inc. (Planmac) has been retained by the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury (BWG) to undertake a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) and Detailed Design for improvements to Line 8 from Barrie Street to Sideroad 10 including Sideroad 10 from north of Line 8 to Reagens Industrial Parkway. A Class Environmental Assessment Study was completed for Sideroad 10 widening in 2008. This EA Study will identify improvements along Line 8 as well confirm the ultimate configuration of Sideroad 10. The future transportation and municipal servicing infrastructure needs are being examined as part of the study, including the potential widening of Line 8 to accommodate increase traffic volumes and to address roadway capacity, operational and safety deficiencies, intersection upgrades, extension of municipal services, drainage improvements and extension of active transportation facilities.

**The Process**

The Class Environmental Assessment process will follow the planning and design process for Schedule C projects as described in the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Document (October 2000 as amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015), published by the Municipal Engineers Association. Alternatives will be evaluated based on technical and environmental factors and consultation with the public and stakeholders. Two Public Information Centres (PICs) will be held during this study to provide the public with the opportunity to discuss the project and provide input to the Project Team. An Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be prepared and made available for public review at the completion of the study.

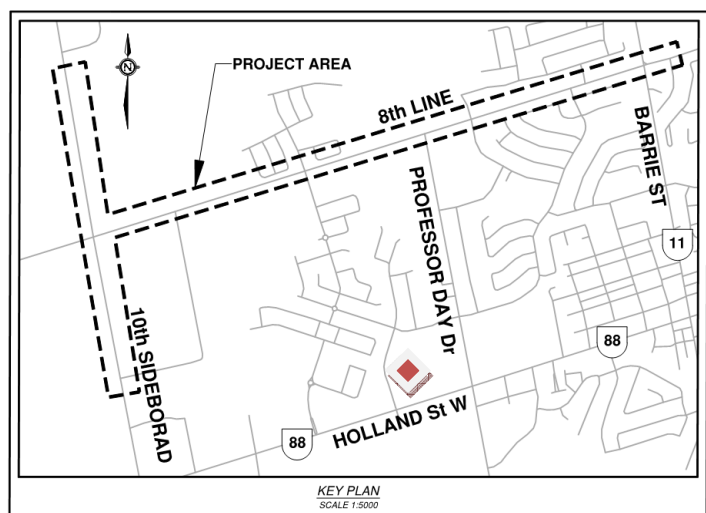
The first of the two PICs has been arranged to introduce the Study and present the Problem /Opportunity Statement, Alternative Solutions to the Problem or Opportunity and the Preliminary Preferred Solution(s). This PIC will be an informal drop in format, during which time the applicable study material and display boards will be available. Representatives of the Project Team will be on hand to answer individual questions in a one-on-one format, pertaining to the Project and the Class EA Process. The second PIC will occur later in the study and will present the evaluation of alternative design concepts and the preferred plan.
