

Temporary Water Shutdown

November 6, 2017

WHAT:

Water service to your area of **Scanlon Avenue between Nelson Street and Barrie Street, as well as the intersection of Barrie Street and Scanlon Avenue between Joseph Street and John Street**, will be shut down for a short period to facilitate the transferring of the water services from the existing watermain to the new watermain.

WHEN:

Your water will be shut off on **Wednesday, November 8th, 2017**.

The Shutdown will take place only during the hours of **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** If the weather prevents work from occurring, the shutdown will be on the following working day.

HOW YOU MAY BE AFFECTED:

Please let us know if you have any special health conditions that could be affected by this shut down or if you have any questions or concerns.

It may be necessary to store some extra water for your needs prior to the shutdown period.
