

NOTICE: Tree Removal

March 15, 2018

South West Arterial Road – Sideroad 10 & Line 6

WHAT:

To prepare the “Employment Lands” located in the area of Highway 400 between County Road 88 and Line 5 for new development, the Town is preparing for the South West Arterial Road widening project.

To conduct this work, the Town must remove trees within the public right-of-way along Sideroad 10, between Line 5 and Holland Street as well as on Line 6 approximately 300m east and west of Sideroad 10. This will allow the Town to conduct the necessary utility relocations and road widening in the future.

WHERE:

This focus of the tree removal work will be along Sideroad 10 between Line 5 and Holland Street and Line 6 immediately east and west of Sideroad 10.

WHEN:

The Town’s contractor is expected to begin the work late March 2018 – weather dependant – and is expected to wrap up by May of this year.

HOW YOU MAY BE AFFECTED:

The work will be contained within the right-of-way and will not occur on private property. In addition to the tree removal work, select farm fence removal, and general restoration at the locations where contractor has disturbed the ground.

As part of the future road work, the Town has allotted for boulevard trees to be planted along the new road alignment to help offset the removal of the trees this year. However, the replanting of these boulevard trees will not take place until the road work has neared completion.
