## Watermain Cleaning (swabbing) Program

### WHERE:

**Area No. 1:** Hulst Drive, Magani Avenue (from Collings Avenue to Hulst Drive), Collings Avenue, Maplegrove Avenue (to Collings Avenue), Valleyview Crescent, Maurino Court, Luxury Avenue, Kulpin Avenue, Maple Court, Fred Cook Drive.

**Area No 2:** Booth Street, Milligan Street, Aishford Road (from Saint Avenue to Langford Boulevard), Rutherford Road, Gwillimbury Drive, Faris Street, and Liberty Crescent.

### WHEN:

- June 05 through June 16, 2017
- Swabbing to take place Monday to Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

### WHAT:

In order to maintain the high quality of BWG's drinking water a swabbing program is conducted annually. This consists of inserting a foam swab through selected watermains to remove any buildup of naturally occurring sediments.

Swabbing work will be performed by the Ontario Clean Water Agency under the direction of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury's Water Department.

### HOW YOU MAY BE AFFECTED:

Individual notices will be hand delivered at least 24 hour prior to swabbing, advising owners when their street will be cleaned and advising that no water should be used during the affected periods.

Should you experience discoloured water, please turn on the cold water in your laundry tub or bathtub and allow the water to run for 5 minutes or until clear. If the water does not clear, please call our office at 905-775-5369 ext. 2300, Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:00am to 4:00pm.

For emergency water-related issues, please contact the South Simcoe Police Station at 905-775-3311 and they will contact the Town's on-call staff.
