

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC DELAYS

ROAD MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

WHERE:

Canal Road from Side Road 5 east to Highway 400.

WHEN:

Work is tentatively scheduled for July 17 to 21, 2017.

WHAT:

This road is scheduled to be resurfaced later this summer. In preparation, we will be removing the elevated grass and gravel shoulder along the south side of Canal Road between Side Road 5 and Highway 400. This will prevent water from ponding on the road, reducing water damage to the road surface and ice build-up during the winter, as well as preventing sod damage and improving drainage. The additional space will also increase passing clearance for larger vehicles.

HOW YOU MAY BE AFFECTED:

ALL TRAFFIC: Traffic through the active work area will be controlled and merged into a single lane, resulting in short delays.

LOCAL RESIDENTS: Where the road borders residential lawns, a portion of the sand/grass in the public right-of-way will be stripped to create a shoulder at the same elevation as the road, and approximately 1.5m from the edge of the paved surface. The width of this removal will be kept to a minimum. **Residents along this stretch of road are asked to remove any physical items from along the frontage of your lot and mark any in-ground devices (such as underground sprinklers) to prevent damage.**
