Notice of Complete Applications and Public Meeting on a Proposed Draft Plan of Subdivision and Zoning By-law Amendment

Pursuant to Sections 34 and 51 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13*, as amended

Take notice that the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury has received the following complete applications:

Owner/Applicant: Mod-Aire Homes Limited
Location: Blocks 178 & 179, Plan 51M-1075
File Nos.: D12-17-17 and D14-17-14

And take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury will be holding a public meeting on **Tuesday, April 3, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Zima Room of the BWG Library & Cultural Centre, 425 Holland Street West, Bradford**, to consider the proposed draft plan of subdivision and Zoning By-law amendment. (Please note that there may be more than one public meeting and that the matter will be dealt with in the order that it appears on the agenda.)

The applicant is proposing a residential plan of subdivision consisting of 94 detached dwelling lots, and two (2) streets. The lands included in the draft plan would be rezoned to implement standards for the proposed subdivision. A key map showing the location of the lands is attached.

Additional information regarding the proposal is available for public inspection during regular office hours at the Office of Community Planning located at 305 Barrie Street, Unit 2, Bradford.

The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of the nature of the proposal, invite public input, and answer questions regarding the applications.

Any person may attend the public meeting to make written or verbal representation in support of or in opposition to the proposed draft plan of subdivision and Zoning By-law amendment. If you wish to be notified of Council's decision regarding the proposed Draft Plan of Subdivision and Zoning By-law Amendment, you must submit a written request to Alan Wiebe at the address shown in the paragraph above.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the proposed draft plan of subdivision is approved or the proposed Zoning By-law amendment is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the proposed plan of subdivision is approved or the proposed zoning by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
