
How does an HCD work?

- Designation allows municipal Council to adopt district plan with policies and guidelines tailored to area
- Ensures significance/character of areas protected in long-term by managing change
- Proposed changes are subject to permit process under Ontario Heritage Act
- Town staff review permits in relation to District Plan, ensure alterations, demolitions, and new construction comply
- Designation allows municipalities to maintain strong sense of place and identity






Study Area Bond Head Settlement Area boundary

HCD Designation Process

1. Request to designate

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Phase 2

- 2. Consultation with the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury Municipal Heritage Committee
- 3. OP revisions [revisions suggested in Phase 1 report]
- 4. Identify study area and contemplate interim control
- 5. Evaluation of cultural heritage resources and attributes
- 6. Determine boundary of study area and potential HCD

HCD Designation Process cont.

Future Work – HCD Plan

7. Preparation of the HCD Plan and Guidelines

- 8. Passing of designation bylaw and adoption of HCD Plan
- 9. Registration of bylaw on title
- 10. Notification of passing of bylaw to Ontario Heritage Trust
- 11. Proposed changes to existing bylaws and OP provisions
- 12. Implementing HCD Plan

Phase 1 Tasks: Background & Issues Identification Report

- General research Bond Head's history, cultural heritage resources
- Reviewed land use planning and heritage policies
- Reviewed merits of HCD designation in area's conservation
- Field investigation and database population
- Identification of project issues and challenges
- Thorough public engagement program




Public Consultation

- Key stakeholders identified during Phase 1:
 - Bond Head property owners
 - Business, community, resident associations
 - Heritage Committee
 - Elected officials
 - BWG staff
 - General public
- Phase 1 engagement initiatives:
 - Public Open House (May 9, 2018)
 - Village Character Assessment Survey mailed to Bond Head residents (hardcopy)
 - 41.1% response rate
 - 6.7% (5) respondents indicated they do not live or own property in Bond Head
 - Dedicated webpage on Town's website
 - Banner on Town's website homepage
 - Posts promoting public meeting on Town's website
 - Project emails to interested members of public
 - Regular social media posts
 - Newspaper ads in Simcoe.ca
 - Posters in public venues
 - Presentation to Municipal Heritage Committee
 - Article in *Bradford West Gwillimbury Topic*
