Decision of Council

Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury approved By-law 2026-021 on the 7th day of April, 2026 pursuant to section 41(1) and 41.1(1) of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18, for the village of Bond Head. A key map showing the location of the lands to which the by-law applies is attached.

The purpose and effect of By-law 2026-021 is to designate the Bond Head Heritage Conservation District and to adopt the Bond Head Heritage Conservation District Plan of February 2026 in accordance with Sections 41(1) and 41.1(1) of the *Ontario Heritage Act*. Box 100, Bradford, Ontario, L3Z 2A7, **which must be received no later than May 13, 2026. NOTE: Notices may be dropped in the mail slot at 100 Dissette Street. Units 7 and 8. up to the deadline.**
