




Understanding Property Boundaries in BWG




Land located between your front property and rear property line is considered “private”. This does not include the ROW, which typically includes utilities such as hydro, telecommunications, gas and other services.

NO CURB CUTS:
Curbs are Town property and must **NOT** be altered in any way .



Important infrastructure like trees, hydro, storm and sanitary drains and water shut off valves exist in the ROW and **MUST NOT** be tampered with.



The ROW is commonly located between the travelled portion of the road and front property line of adjoining lands. Anything located within the ROW **MUST** fall within the **PERMITTED** category.
