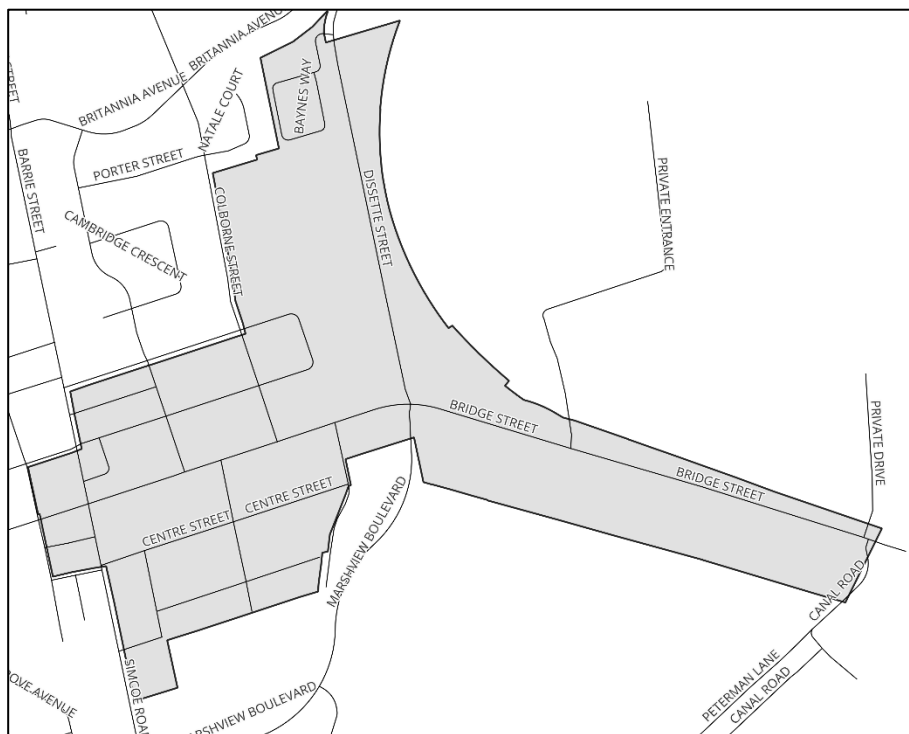
Help Shape the Future of Bradford West Gwillimbury!
